The context

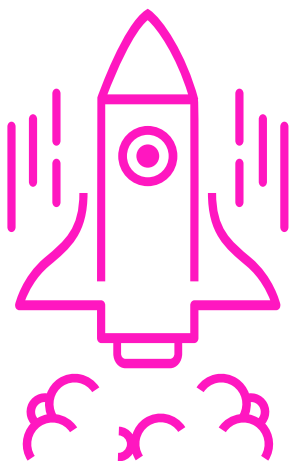
The aim of this study is to evaluate the efficacy and safety of the New.COv2.S vaccine for the prevention of Covid-19 related to SARS-CoV-2 infection.

MissionTEC was commissioned to carry out the tasks necessary for the follow-up of the study in the patients' homes.

MissionTEC's role

Thanks to its large network of research nurses and site coordinators, the MissionTEC's teams were able to carry out the following tasks in patients' homes :

- Taking of vitals signs
- Blood sampling
- Centrifugation
- Saliva tests



The objectives

- Demonstrate the effectiveness of the vaccine
- To evaluate the effect of the vaccine on the viral load of SARSCoV-2
- Assessing adverse effects caused by the vaccine
